## **Survey Report**

#### **Regular Survey Results:**

#### **Important findings:**

Danny's Ride is making a huge difference in the lives of those receiving rides through the program. 98% said that Danny's Ride helped them, and 89% rated Danny's Ride 5 out of 5 when asked to rate how helpful it was.

A full 86.5% would not have been able to get to their appointment without Danny's Ride, and only 20% of the respondents indicated that they had other options, which included walking or riding a bicycle.

The open-ended questions reveal that the impact on riders is extensive and broad. They mentioned not only "getting where they needed to go" when asked how Danny's Ride helped them, they also noted things like maintaining and regaining child custody, avoiding long walks in bad weather with accompanying health problems, not having to take small children on the bus, less stress, getting to work and job interviews, earning enough to buy a car, complying with court requirements and staying out of jail. This in addition to traditional 'recovery' services, such as outpatient and other programs.

Danny's Ride impacts people at the very core of their lives.

40%: Danny's Ride helped them get where they needed to go – general comments to that effect

60% mentioned a specific benefit(s). These include:

33%: jail/court: comply with court requirements, stay out of jail, meet with probation officers, attend court dates

25%: not having a drivers' license, or being able to get a one through the activities they were able to complete with the help of Danny's Ride

21%: children: comply with requirements to regain or maintain custody, being able to take child to medical appointment, being able to bring child with them on their Danny's Ride, avoiding long stressful bus trips with children in tow

17%: Intensive Outpatient and Outpatient appointments

17%: either don't have a car or can't afford car insurance. One said they were able to buy a car after obtaining employment with the help of Danny's Ride.

17%: employment, getting to job interviews, getting and/or keeping a job.

12.5%: money they saved by not having to secure a ride another way

12.5%: helped them avoid taking inaccessible buses – requiring long rides, difficult with children, enduring cold weather with medical conditions that make it difficult.

8%: medical appointments

#### **Treatment Court Survey Results:**

## **Important findings:**

Danny's Ride is a valued resource by the people who received rides as part of their Treatment Court program. It's important to note that Treatment Court requirements are mandated, so even without reasonable transportation options, people still have to find a way to fulfill them. Some of the main benefits of Danny's Ride, to the riders, are illustrated in the question asking people to select the statements that most represent the ways Danny's Ride helped. Over 90% report that it helped people achieve and maintain sobriety. 71% are saving money desperately needed for day-to-day expenses for themselves and their families.

61% said they would not have met mandated requirements, or at least, they were unsure how they would have done so. Of the 39% who thought they would have still met the requirements, none had easy access to alternatives. They would have had to ask anyone they could find for rides. Given that more than half of the respondents used over 20 rides, that represents a lot of favors to be called in. 57% report avoiding program extension for missing mandated requirements, and the same number report being able to avoid people unhealthy to their recovery, by not having to scrounge for a ride.

These rides are making a difference for the individuals who receive them, making treatment court success available to more people who strive to do so, but who otherwise lack transportation.

#### **Pro-A Employment Survey**

## **Important findings:**

The rides received by the Pro-A participants clearly helped them get to job interviews and to obtain jobs. 62% would not have been able to get to work without Danny's Ride.

That said, a third do not have a plan to continue getting to work without Danny's Ride. One individual said it would be helpful if the rides could continue through someone receiving his or her first paycheck. Given the lack of options available to these individuals in terms of alternative options, that might be a reasonable adjustment to the program going forward.

The people surveyed all had only a few months on the job. Most less than three months, with a few between three and six. It is not clear how they will fare in the long run, but all agree that getting a job was much more within reach thanks to the rides they received from Danny's Ride.

Being able to provide transportation to job interviews and work is clearly an important element for people who don't drive, and one that will result in more people working.
