## ANNUAL REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

### FROM IDEA TO INFRASTRUCTURE

In its fifth year of operations, Danny's Ride functions as established infrastructure—embedded in the work of partner organizations and relied upon by individuals navigating health care, recovery, legal obligations, and employment.

What distinguishes Danny's Ride is not just volume, but reliability. Rides are provided consistently, without judgment, and in coordination with existing systems of care. This allows partner organizations to focus on their core work, knowing that transportation will not be the reason progress stalls.

Over time, Danny's Ride has become a practical solution to a persistent challenge: turning plans into participation. When transportation is dependable, appointments are kept, employment is maintained, and recovery supports remain accessible.

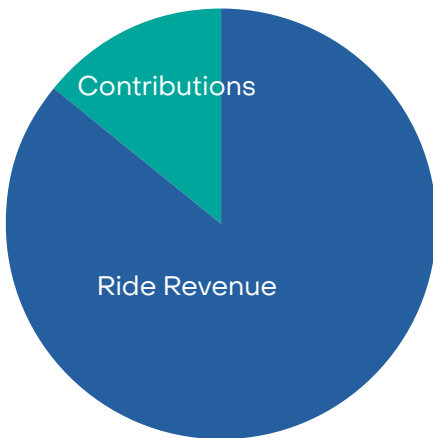

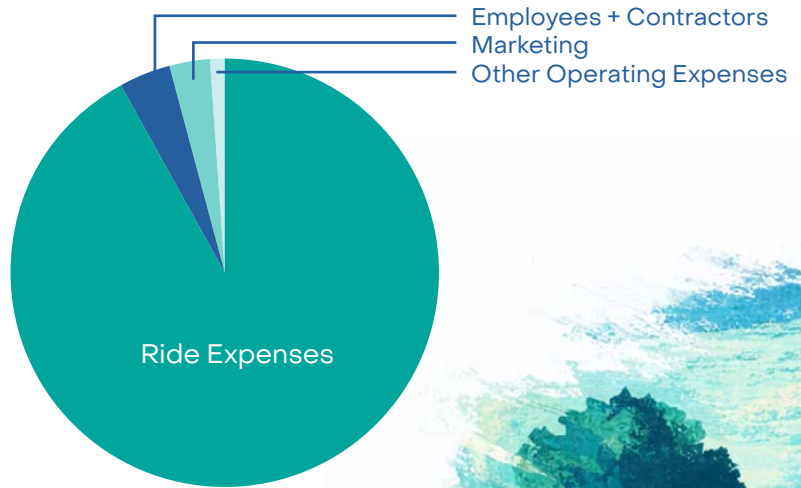
